



Privacy Policy

Accessible Resources for Independence, Inc. is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the Accessible Resources for Independence, Inc.'s Web site and governs data collection and usage. By using the Accessible Resources for Independence, Inc.'s website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Accessible Resources for Independence, Inc. collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Accessible Resources for Independence, Inc. also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Accessible Resources for Independence, Inc.. Use of your Personal Information
